As a member of the Service Leadership Council you will have an opportunity to:

- Lead a Service Team... each SLC member will develop a relationship with a non-profit organization in the community where they will spend 1-3 hours per week serving. There is also an expectation that SLC members will challenge other students to serve alongside them. Reflect upon your experiences in weekly logs.
- Develop a deeper understanding of Jesus' commandment to Love your Neighbor
- Cultivate a lifestyle of service
- Dialogue with others about important issues in our community
- Interact in book discussions

The Service Leadership Council is a team of students united to encourage and equip HBU students to meet real needs in the Houston community by being the hands and feet of Christ.

Requirements for the SLC position include:

- Meet regularly with agency supervisor.
- Meet regularly with the Director of ACTS.
- Attend all Service Leadership Council meetings (The only exception to this is if the meeting is set during a class. Otherwise, all meetings are mandatory.
- Attend the SLC retreat in August (date made available in the Spring)
- Carry the regular academic load for normal progress toward graduation
- Have a maturing faith in Jesus Christ.
- Maintain a GPA of cumulative 2.5 or higher
