Beta Beta Beta (TriBeta) is an honor society for students, particularly undergraduates, dedicated to improving the understanding and appreciation of biological study and extending boundaries of human knowledge through scientific research. Beta Beta Beta Biological Honor Society seeks to encourage scholarly activity and to promote a better appreciation of the value of biology. Since its founding in 1922, more than 20,000 persons have been accepted into lifetime membership, and more than 553 chapters have been established throughout the United States and Puerto Rico. Beta Beta Beta reserves its regular membership for those who achieve superior academic records and who indicate special aptitude for and major interest in the natural sciences. Beta Beta Beta members are encouraged to become involved in scientific investigation and report their findings in the journal of the society, *BIOS*.

Members of Beta Beta Beta will be selected based on their GPA, service to the Biology Department, HBU, and the community, and interest in biologic activities including research. Members major in Biology or Biochemistry/Molecular Biology and have completed at least 3 semesters and 3 biology courses at HBU. Minimally, 2 B's and 1 A must be earned in these biology courses and members must maintain at least a 3.3 cumulative GPA. Members should be dedicated to Beta Beta Beta and have accrued at least five fundraising points and five events points as Biology Club members. Minimally, two points must be earned each semester.

However, BIOL or BCMB students that do not meet the above grade requirements, but have maintained at least a 3.0 in their biology courses and demonstrated outstanding service to Beta Beta Beta will be considered for membership and are thus encouraged to apply.
