

## **Retention of Undergraduate Students Fall 2009 to Spring 2010**

### **Executive Summary**

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of undergraduate students enrolled in the Fall 2009 term. Using the Banner system, students were classified as enrolled, withdrawn, or graduated for Spring 2010. Those classified as graduated received their degrees in Fall 2009. The tables that follow look at four different (but overlapping) cohorts of students: all undergraduates, new freshmen, new freshmen who were provisionally admitted, and new transfer students.

With both 2008-09 and 2009-10 on the semester calendar, the retention rates from both years are easily compared. Three of the four cohorts of students showed significant year-over-year declines in fall to spring retention from 2008-09 to 2009-10. The overall fall to spring retention rate for undergraduates who did not graduate is 84.9%, down just over four percent. For new freshmen, the retention rate is 85.0%, down almost seven percent, while retention for provisionally admitted students dropped almost ten percent. The undergraduate and new freshmen rates are approximately the same as in 2007-08, indicating that the higher 2008-09 rates may have been an anomaly (especially given that there was only a small increase in Fall 2008 to Fall 2009 retention – see Institutional Research report [IR090.005 Retention of Undergraduate Students, Fall 2008 to Fall 2009](#) for more information).

The data indicates that attendance at Welcome Days is a strong predictor of freshman retention; 92.7% of the 369 new freshmen attending Welcome Days returned for the spring, while less than 70% of the 185 non-attendees returned. By major, 20.5% of non returning new freshmen had a declared major of Nursing; for new transfers, 46.6% of the non-returning students had a major in Nursing.

Please note that tables are included on SOAR and Welcome Days attendance, and on Fall 2009 GPA and cumulative GPA at the end of the Fall 2009 term.

### **Main Report**

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of the 2,306 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2009 who were classified Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors, or Seniors. Benchmark values for 2006-07 through 2008-09 are also provided for comparison purposes. Students who entered in Summer 2009 were counted as new students (either freshman or transfer) in Fall 2009 as well. Twenty-seven postbaccalaureate students from the total undergraduate enrollment of 2,333 have been excluded.

Retention percentages for the various cohorts for Fall 2009 to Spring 2010 are below, along with comparable numbers from 2006-07 through 2008-09.

Of the 2,306 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2009:

- 107 (4.6% ) graduated in December 2009
- 331 (14.4%) did not return for Spring 2010
- 1,868 (81.0%) reenrolled for Spring 2010

After adjusting for graduates, the undergraduate retention rate was 84.9%. See Section 1, page 3, for more details.

Of the 554 new freshmen enrolled in Fall 2009:

- 83 (15.0%) did not return for Spring 2010
- 471 (85.0%) reenrolled for Spring 2010

The retention rate for new freshmen was 85.0%. See Section 2, page 10 for more details.

Of the 86 new provisionally admitted students in Fall 2009:

- 26 (30.2%) did not return for Spring 2010
- 60 (69.8%) reenrolled for Spring 2010

The retention rate for new provisionally admitted students was 69.8%. See Section 3, page 16 for more details.

Of the 236 new transfer students in Fall 2009:

- 58 (24.6%) did not return for Spring 2010
- 178 (75.4%) reenrolled for Spring 2010

The retention rate for new transfers was 75.4%. See Section 4, page 2, for more details.

The four sections of this report (below) focus on the four cohorts listed above. Retention patterns for each cohort are displayed by gender, ethnicity, minority status, citizenship, test score ranges, classification, high school quartiles, residency (on- or off-campus and county), and attendance at SOAR/Welcome Days (for New Freshmen, Provisional Admits, and New Transfers). Additionally, a table of majors of the non-returning students is included.

Please note that in the tables that follow, "Withdrawn" does not refer to students who have gone through an official withdrawal process with the University. It refers to students who have not graduated and who have not enrolled for the Spring 2010 term.
