



## Profile of Graduate Students Fall 2006 and Fall 2007

### Fall 2007

The graduate student enrollment of 347 includes 99 students who entered the University in Summer 2007 or Fall 2007. Demographically, seventy percent (241) of the graduate students are female, and 42.1 percent (146) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-four percent (23.9%) of the group. Ninety-three percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Forty-nine percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Approximately 27 percent are seeking a Master's degree in Business Administration, with 21 percent seeking a Master of Arts in Psychology and 18 percent a Master of Education degree.

### Fall 2006<sup>2</sup>

The graduate student enrollment of 328 include 107 students who entered the University in Summer 2006 or Fall 2006. Demographically, seventy-two percent (237) of the graduate students are female, and 44.5 percent (146) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up approximately twenty-six percent (26.2%) of the group. Ninety-five percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Forty percent of graduate students are classified as full-time. Approximately 27 percent are seeking a Master of Education degree, with 25 percent seeking a Master of Arts in Psychology and 24 percent a Master's degree in Business Administration.

1. Test score data is not generally entered into Banner for graduate students, so test scores are not included in this report. Additionally, most graduate students list their permanent address as their local address, so state and county information is not included.

2. Fall 2006 data was pulled from data frozen on the census date in Fall 2006, and did not undergo the same data quality checks and cleansing as data from Fall 2007. This includes reconciliation of student numbers from Recruitment PLUS to Banner.
